Outcomes

Reaching the finals and semi-finals of several sporting events e.g. netball, tennis and quad kids at Level 2 competition and cricket and swimming at Level 3 (county) competition. Having our most successful year to date at Area Athletics – the relay team in particular performed very well as a result of athletics lesson coaching. All year group teachers have had the benefit of PE coaching, in key skills areas of gymnastics, games and dance. All year groups have had an additional sports club offered – i.e. early morning sport, lunchtime or after school activities, which provided high quality sports coaching. All children in the school have had specialist coaching in some form during PE sessions. The SSP coach has become part of the staff team and is well respected by adults and children alike. The additional funding has enabled all staff to receive training in dance and other areas. It has also facilitated additional competition opportunities which we wish to build on next year.
