<p>Supporting off-site visits:</p> <p>Supporting costs associated with residential visits (Hollowford Centre and Manor Farm Adventures) and numerous day visits (e.g. Beaumanor Hall, Bosworth Battlefield, Warning Zone etc). This allows pupils to attend residential and day visits organised by the school, extending their learning and wider social experiences.</p>	£2,805
<p>Intervention:</p> <p>Targeted intervention work with Teachers, Cover Supervisors or HLTA staff. This work is carried out either 1:1 or in small group sessions on specific programmes to boost attainment with our identified group of children (e.g. phonics, IT, basic skills). Cover Supervisors are employed for 38 hours per week and LSAs for 27 hours per week for this purpose.</p>	£36,919
<p>Intervention:</p> <p>Employment of a Cover Supervisor/Teacher to run targeted intervention groups e.g. Reading Booster</p> <p>iPad for each year group to use in PP group work</p>	£7,095 £2,240
<p>Family Support:</p> <p>Financial support to individual families appropriate to their needs.</p> <p>Milk for Free School Meals children</p>	£129 £449
<p>Additional LSA staff</p> <p>Employment of an apprentice LSA (Sept to Mar) to support classroom activities and release other experienced staff to work with groups or specific children</p>	£2,703
