The Context of our School

Ashby Willesley is a two form entry primary school on the outskirts of the small rural town of Ashby de la Zouch. It is an over subscribed school with medium to low levels of deprivation. Out of 273 primary schools in the county, Ashby Willesley was ranked 184th most deprived in 2017-18. Pupil premium currently accounts for just over 9% of the school's population and, as identified in this report, some year groups contain very small numbers of PP which can lead to distortions of data.

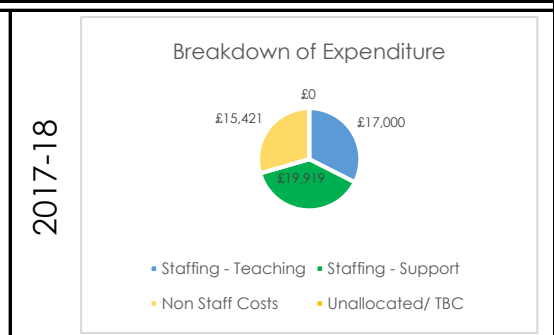
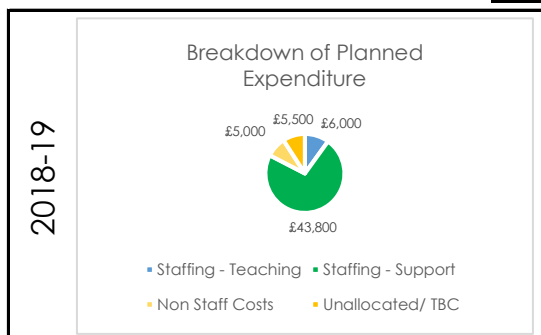
