Another successful year! Thank you to everyone who has given up their time to attend meetings, plan events, set up events and run events. A fantastic £5,600 was raised through some brilliant events.

The Christmas Fair was the most successful ever raising just over £2,300, and the Spring Fair and Willesley's Got Talent raised just short of £1,500. All of these events take a lot of time in the planning and a great deal of effort is put in by a talented group of parents in the months before the actual event and for that we are very grateful. The success of the event on the day is thanks to the number of teachers and parents that volunteer their time; again this is very much appreciated

The brilliant Willesley tea towels at Christmas last year also raised a staggering £630. We are busy coordinating the 2018 fundraiser which we hope will be as big a success!

Star Foundation recycling and Easy Fundraising have proved to be successful with cheques totaling £600 being provided by the organisations to the PTA. The Star Foundation funds helped to provide a beat boxing performance, plus a story-telling session for Foundation and Key Stage 1. Both of which were immensely enjoyed by the children!

Funds raised was spent on new iPads for the school (£4,800), as well as continuing our commitment to provide lunchtime play equipment for the children (£300).

Our 2018.2019 annual commitments are £2,505.00:

Funds currently available are £7,000. As per our constitution £1,500 remains in the bank, therefore after our on-going commitments to supply lunchtime games in each of the 3 terms (£300), the pantomime trip (£1,760), the Welcome to Willesley Party (£75) and the Year 6 Leavers Disco (£250) we have £3,000 available to the school to aid in providing equipment and experiences for the children. We will be asking Year 6 and the Purple Parliament to provide some suggestions as to where they would like some of the money raised go towards for the school.
